### What is (i)Cleveland Summer?

(i)Cleveland Summer is an offering of [Cleveland Leadership Center](#). The program builds Cleveland's future by connecting your college interns to Greater Cleveland's vibrant cultural and community resources. The summer program includes:

- *Two full-day sessions (June and July):* Interns explore new neighborhoods, meet community leaders who are advancing the region, and become connected to Cleveland's vital social and civic scenes. The June session includes neighborhood immersions and a downtown scavenger hunt. The July session includes behind-the-scenes exploration of Cleveland's recreational spaces and arts and culture scene. Session dates are determined by interns' cohort (A, B, or C).
- *Power lunches:* Interns attend at least two small-group Power Lunches where they have the opportunity to gain an insider's perspective on careers and leadership lessons from leaders at corporate, nonprofit and civic organizations in and around Cleveland.
- *Young professional mentors:* Interns have the option to be assigned a summer mentor for an authentic look at life as a young professional in Cleveland. (i)Cleveland mentors provide career and personal guidance and welcome interns to join them in their activities and community involvements.

### How much does (i)Cleveland Summer cost?

Tuition is \$250 per intern, payable at the time of registration or by June 1. This includes all activities, meals and arranged transportation.

### What is the return on our investment?

- Interns who are excited to build relationships in the civic and business community, and can envision their future in Cleveland.
- Outstanding visibility for your organization among our (i)Cleveland students and other participating businesses.
- A priceless experience for your interns beyond their professional role.

### What will our interns gain from the program?

### **Who is in (i)Cleveland?**

Up to 225 undergraduate college students. Any college student interning in Northeast Ohio is eligible. Most participants are sponsored by their employers. (i)Cleveland interns have represented companies across Northeast Ohio.

### **What is the time investment for interns?**

Interns participate in two full Friday sessions and two power lunches (12:00 - 1:00 p.m.) during the summer. They are also invited to optional evening socials as well as various community events.

### **What are the (i)Cleveland Summer 2018 dates?**

- Kick Off Social: TBD
- Cohort A: Friday, June 8 and Friday, July 13, 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- Cohort B: Friday, June 15 and Friday, July 20, 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- Cohort C: Friday, June 22 and Friday, July 27, 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- Power Lunches: Summer dates TBD, 12:00 – 1:00 p.m. (interns select two)

### **How do I register or reserve spots for interns?**

The deadline to register is June 1; however, we anticipate that the program will fill earlier than the deadline. You are able to add or remove spots up to June 1 or until the program is filled. Intern information will be collected at a later date. You do not need to know the identity of your interns to reserve spots.
