Provides students with access to exclusive professional opportunities and contacts to help them launch their career.

Gives students a behind-the-scenes look at, and hands-on experience in, the civic sector which connects them to community.

Instills leadership skills and a desire to get involved.

WHY CAMPUS CLEVELAND?

Campus Cleveland immerses young people in the community and connects them with the people, projects and ideas advancing NEO. Establishing these strong connections helps expand the talent pool to ensure a thriving future for Cleveland.

Ability to find opportunities to use talents and strengths to make a difference in the community.

After the program, 69% of last year's participants stated they can find community engagement opportunities relevant to their interests and abilities as opposed to only 19% before the program.
