OnBoard Cleveland is a leadership and civic development experience tailored for early-career professionals. OBC's curriculum is designed to enhance communication skills, strengthen workplace presence, create an awareness of the civic realm, and better connect employees to their organizations and civic engagement opportunities.

Participants leave the program energized and equipped to make a positive difference in their workplace and the community.

Class members learn about and gain accelerated connections to civic opportunities that align with their personal interests and talents.

Helps participants understand critical issues, assets and collaborative leadership within Cleveland's civic infrastructure.

Guides participants to analyze and employ individual strengths to maximize contributions in professional settings and community involvements.

Develops skills for confident networking, presentations, and professional interactions.

After the program, 89% of last year's participants stated they are able to use information about the community to envision Cleveland's future, as opposed to just 6% before the program.
